Enclosed is the final report on our evaluation of three Seagull*IV X-1 drinking water purification systems according to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Guide Standard and Protocol for testing Microbiological Water Purifiers.

As indicated in the report, the Seagull®IV X-1 systems passed the EPA Guide Standard for all three classes of microbiological contaminants exceeding the recommended removal levels of bacteria (Klebsiella terrigena, 99.9999%), protozoan cysts (Cryptosporidium cysts, 99.9%), and enteric viruses (polivirus and rotavirus, 99.99%).
